The organization undertakes the projects under the broad areas like healthcare, education, women empowerment and food for hungry & destitute.

Menstrual Hygiene & Health Education :

Menstrual hygiene management is an essential aspect of hygiene for women and adolescent girls between menarche and menopause. Despite being an important issue concerning women and girls in the menstruating age group, MHH is often overlooked in rural areas due to absence of proper knowledge and resources.



We organize MHH programme to aware and educate the women and

girls in villages of Amer and Jamwaramgarh blocks in Jaipur. NSSS also support them by providing sanitary pads at free of cost. As part of our women empowerment programme, we also train women to make sanitary pads by themselves

Goals and Objectives :

- Awareness, Education & Training Social Support

Project Output :

- More than 149 awareness camps in several villages and 14,900 women were provided with menstrual education.
- Sanitary Pads distributed in 149 villages.
- Sanitary pad making training to 20 women.



Self-Help Groups (SHGs) :

- An SHG is a small group of women who come together to make regular monetary contributions. Many SHGs have already made a significant contribution in developing entrepreneurship aptitudes among rural women by enhancing their skills and giving them a chance to engage in various entrepreneurial activities. SHGs provide women entrepreneurs with micro-loans to sustain their businesses, while also creating an environment for them to develop greater agency and decision making skills. We form SHGs and run different skills programme.

Medical Camp :

A free medical camp can be considered as a life-saving program that aims to provide free medical to the poor communities living in rural and urban areas by a mobile team with varieties of medical specialized services. The objective of the camps was to provide information regarding diet, exercise, weight control and basic health care. Free medicines have been provided to the people in need. We organized 6 camps in Nimla, Shrinagar, Koliyo ki Dhani, Paota, Lalwas and Dhool Raoji villages



Goals and Objectives :

Provide with initial health care to the people in life-threatening conditions. To provide primary health care facilities at their door step.



Project Output :

- 6 Medical Camps Organized.
- 1,800+ beneficiaries.



Ration Distribution :

Ration kits distribution in Amer & Jamwaramgarh blocks. This project helps the needy (widows, orphans, adults, physically disabled & senior citizens) individual and families. Ration kits were distributed in several villages to support the incapable communities. the student who performed well in academic are rewarded with wrist watch. A Ration contained: Flour, Rice, Pulse, Spices, Soap, Detergent and Oil etc. We served in 30+ villages in Jamwaramgarh, 25+ villages in Amer, 4+ areas in Jaipur.



Goals and Objectives :

- Ration kits distribution to needy communities.

Project Output :

- 3,000+ Ration kits distributed to needy families.
- 4 Wristwatches given to students



Group Marriage :

A marriage needs excess amount of money & resources. The financially weak people can not afford such expenses. Poor families in rural areas take loans to arrange a marriage while the rest of their life is spent repaying the loan. Group marriage is more cost efficient and reduces the burden of marriage. So we took an initiatives to arrange a marriage ceremony to help the helpless people. we selected the adults from poor families and arrange their marriage. Also distribute a set of household items without charging them a single penny.



Goals and Objectives :

Group marriage of orphans and the poor . Household gears distribution



Project Output :

- 21 Couples began their happy married life.
- Household gears set distributed to each pair.
- Savings in food, money, energy and resources.
- Hand holding support from NSSS.
- We are planning for their livelihood setup.



Group Marriage :

We serve according to the need of society. The life of a poor people is very tough and when it comes to marriage the situation worsens. therefore we came up with the responsibility to arrange their marriages. The process is begins after selecting the beneficiaries. We selected orphans, Handicaps, Widows and adults from financially weak families. No money has been charged from any individual. We arranged all the needs of the program by raising crowd funding. We purchased 21 sets of basic household items like Almira, Dressing Table, Refrigerator, Bed, Chair, T.V., Iron, Mixer, Utensils, Fan, Sewing machine, cooler, bucket, etc. Along with a set of household items, every couple got the wedding dress. On the wedding day, a local volunteer team and the NSSS members organized the programm at Sharma farmhouse, Gulmohar road, near NH-11, Kukas. A theater team presented a drama on friendship of Krishan and Sudama Life And everyone applauded them. The NSSS gave appreciation certificates to every member. Almost 10,000 people with the chief guests Satish Puniya Ji (Amer MLA, BJP President Raj.), Shrii Rajyavardhan Singh (M.P.), Gopal Meena Ji (MLA Jamwaramghar), and the (Jaipur Mayor) Vishu Lata gave blessings to the couples. C.D.P.O. Officer visited to verify the age of the brides and grooms. In the end, We distributed the 21 sets of households items to the couples as gifts. We assured them that we are always ready to help them in future.



Blanket Distribution:

The objective behind blanket distribution is to provide relief to poor and needy communities during winter season by giving them blankets to people living on streets, slums. Orphans, elderly people and widows were the beneficiaries.



Goals and Objectives :

Project Output :

- Blankets were distributed in Amer and Jamwaramghar villages.
- Orphan, widows, senior citizens and needy people are beneficiaries.



Special Distribution Drives:

On special requests we distribute essential items to the needy. Our motive is “Service to humanity is service to God”. We also celebrate special occasions with orphan & poor children. We always try to make a connection with children to keep them happy and never let them feel estranged from the society.



Goals and Objectives :

To serve the society. Cots distribution to the needy. Sweets distribution to the children.

Project Output :

- Sweets distributed.
- 2 Cots distributed in kiro ki dhani (Kukas)



Remedial Classes :

Students who have difficulty grasping lessons in the classrooms are provided with different educational strategies like more and refined practice, clarification, repetition of content, and in some cases, individual attention is given for conceptual clarity. Remedial classes are provided to the students who need especial guidance from the teachers. The remedial classes specially focus on the topics that have already been taught in the class, the same topics are repeated and explained again in the remedial classes for the students who have difficulty in understanding them easily.



Goals and Objectives :

Additional help to the learners who are lagging behind in classes. To run extra classes centers for rural learners & to support their studies.

Project Output :

- 56 learners join the classes
- Scored better in the academic.
- Significant improvement in learning and comprehension skills
- 1 center started in Rana basti (Kunda).

Stationery Distribution :

Stationery set distributed in Amer & Jamwaramgarh blocks. We made them aware of them the real value of education in the human life. We supported the beneficiary to continue their studies and encouraged the underprivileged children (poor, beggars, semi orphans & physically disabled) to go to school and learn. We did new registrations in the school and provided support and guidance. We also Followed up with orphan caretakers and distributed the study material sets of (pen, pencil, notebook, bag, box, eraser, sharpener etc) to children.



Goals and Objectives :

- To make aware, support & provide the resources to the orphans.

Project Output :

- New 161 unprivileged children enrolled in nearby schools & aprox. 150 children are regular.
- 1,200 stationery sets distributed.
- The Poor, orphans & physically disabled children start going to their Schools and also got help & support.
- Distribution drive in Rana Basti, Shivpura School, Paota, Nackchighati Ghoreat Labana, Andhi, and Kharana.
